SKMM focuses on the major biker events that attract hundreds of thousands of bikers annually. We're all about bringing Jesus to the motorcycle community, using literature, prayer and testimony. We pass out a lot of literature during these events, but not without results.

While at Street Vibrations Fall Rally, Kevin and Kellye Simpson stopped by SKMM's booth. Kevin had left the Adventist Church in high school and Kellye had never been Adventist, but her grandmother had taught her Saturday was the Sabbath. Intrigued by the group, the couple took some literature. Later they were baptized into the Ceres Seventh-day Adventist Church, Calif., where they soon began a new SKMM chapter.

Local chapters will often participate in motorcycle rallies, charity rides, dedication services, or other motorcycle related activities. Personal contact and literature evangelism are the primary methods used to spread the gospel. Chapters will often setup a literature booth at these motorcycle rallies and pass out literature to the bikers.

STURGIS, SOUTH DAKOTA

The Sturgis Motorcycle Rally is held annually in Sturgis, South Dakota usually during the first full week of August. It began in 1938 and was originally held for stunts and races, but has evolved into being a meeting for motorcycle enthusiasts from around the world. It is one of the largest motorcycle rallies in the world.

STREET VIBRATIONS, NEVADA

The Street Vibrations Fall Rally is held annually in Reno, Nevada usually the last week of September. It began in 1993 and has become a celebration of music, metal and motorcycles. Street Vibrations offers tours, live entertainment, ride-in shows, stunt shows and more to more than 50,000 biking enthusiasts.
